What is Being Proposed?

- A 5-storey luxury condominium fronting onto the beach, east of Silverbirch and west of the RC Harris Water Filtration Plant PLUS
- A 4-storey townhouse on Neville Park
- Construction of underground parking for as many as 30 cars, with entrance off Neville Park
- Removal of several 100 year –old trees and more than 30 other trees
- Significant change to the “look and feel” of the beachfront

How Could This Development Affect the Beach?

- It could alter the current character of our beautiful Beach neighbourhoods
- It could set a dangerous precedent for similar type of higher-density development along the Beachfront or on your own street, whether in street-townhouses or apartments
- It could change the lakefront character
